As we head toward the State Tournament in Des Moines, it is imperative that we receive prompt attention to the following requests for information. This information was emailed to ADs and posted online under Baseball.

If your team is still playing in the tournament after **Saturday, July 20**, we need your **TEAM PHOTO, PHOTO ID** sent to us **IMMEDIATELY**. **If you want to send your photo and Photo ID early that is fine.**

PLEASE NOTE FOR STATE PROGRAMS: Stats for players will be pulled from QUIKStats as of 9AM the morning following your Substate Game. It is important to update those games before 9AM the following day. We will pull rosters as soon as a substate is complete (that same night) -- so please update them now on QUIKStats. This information will be used to produce the program. Because of the tight deadlines, we need your **PHOTOS BEFORE you have qualified for the State Tournament because the program will be compiled as soon as Substates are completed.**

If we find ourselves with a rain date during substates, rosters and stats will be downloaded as needed, so please take the time to verify your rosters now.

TEAM PHOTO MUST BE EMAILED: A digital picture, in a "JPEG" or "Tiff" format, sized to 5x7 is preferred. The resolution of the image should be at least 200 pixels/inch with a setting of high to maximum quality. Please send all digital images to celsberry@iahsaa.org. **BE SURE TO INCLUDE ID (FRONT ROW: LEFT TO RIGHT; SECOND ROW: LEFT TO RIGHT; ETC...IN THE EMAIL MESSAGE).**
