

2013 STATE SWIM MEET MEDIA INFORMATION

To obtain State Swim Meet Credentials, media member please following the procedure below:

- (1) TV and print media reporters and photographers – please e-mail your request to Bud Legg at blegg@iahsaa.org **before 12 noon, Wednesday, Feb. 6.** The day of the meet – report to the **swimmer/coach entrance (north side of the Marshalltown Y)** and see Bud Legg for your credential. There will be a section at the end of the pool with some rows marked off for the media to watch and a small media room for you to write. Official results will be posted on-line on the swimming page of our website – www.iahsaa.org
- (2) **One school reporter or photographer** is allowed. He/she needs to contact Bud Legg at the swimmer/coach entrance. ***They must have a letter from a school administrator on a school letterhead stating the name and position of the photographer or reporter. In addition they must purchase a ticket (\$8.00). The individual can trade those two items for a media credential from Mr. Legg at the Swimmers' entrance on the north side of the Marshalltown Y***

In addition, keep in mind:

- During the meet all photographers cannot share with athletes or coaches photos taken. This could result in an athlete or school being disqualified.
- All media are responsible for staying behind roped off areas and away from the edges of the pool. **Flash photography at the start of the races is prohibited.**
- When award winners are announced and on the podium they will be there for a short period of time. Be prepared to get that photo.
- Interviews of athletes and coaches **should not occur until the meet** is completed.
- At all times please observe the requests/instructions of the meet officials.
