

# TENNIS SPECTATOR BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

- ★ **REMEMBER - HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS IS ABOUT EDUCATION AND IS AN EXTENSION OF THE CLASSROOM.** Conduct yourselves in a manner that will make the players you are watching proud of you.
- ★ Never demean any player or coach.
- ★ Be positive when cheering during the match.
- ★ Allow the players on the court to make the calls. Once a call has been made, it becomes history.
- ★ Avoid unnecessary noise during play. This includes cell phones, pagers, etc.
- ★ Do not talk to players from the time they take the court to warm up until the match is over. This includes time-outs and set breaks.
- ★ Stay well away from the fence surrounding the courts so as not to distract any players or hinder any coaches.
- ★ Use of tobacco and alcohol is prohibited during any interscholastic event.

Blatant disregard for these guidelines should be reported your school's athletic administrator so violations can be dealt with on an administrative level, including the Iowa High School Athletic Association, if necessary.
